Many eye problems can develop without warning or symptoms. Conditions such as macular degeneration, glaucoma, retinal tears, retinal detachments, diabetes and high blood pressure can be detected with a thorough examination of the retina.

An Optomap Retinal Exam provides:

- A permanent picture of the retina, providing the largest view of the retina possible without dilation. This will help to confirm a healthy eye and/or aid in the detection of disease.
- **An alternative to pupil dilation in most cases. It is HIGHLY recommended for patients who do not wish to be dilated at the exam.** Dilation may still be necessary if certain eye conditions are discovered.
- Patients who have been diagnosed with Borderline, Type I, or Type II Diabetes are required to be dilated on a yearly basis.
