Intl. Vision exams for glasses or contacts include a free follow up visit for up to 3 months after your initial exam. After this time there will be an office visit charge.
- _____
Intl. Your prescription for glasses and contact lenses will expire one year from the date of your exam. This is in accordance with state laws. (If you return to the office for a recheck, it will still expire from the original exam date)
- _____
Intl. We are unable to give out trial lenses or boxes of contacts after your expiration. You must have a current eye exam.
- _____
Intl. Your doctor recommends that you be dilated or review the Optomap pictures every year. These services are optional. The fee for either service is \$35. Please initial that you understand these services are available to you and you understand that there is a charge.

Dilation ensures that the doctor can take the best care of your eyes by getting a thorough look not only at the front of your eyes but also the back. Side effects are light sensitivity and blurred near vision for several hours.

Optomap screening is available as an alternative to dilation. There are no side effects. The Optomap machine takes a picture of the back of the eye. You will be charged for this service if you review the pictures with your doctor. The doctor will not review the pictures without your consent. *This service is not covered by most insurance.* If you wish to decline this service you must let the doctor know you do not want to view the pictures when the doctor asks you in the exam room.

If you are in need of glasses or contacts after your expiration, please let us know and we will schedule you an appointment as soon as possible. We can try and work you in the same day.
