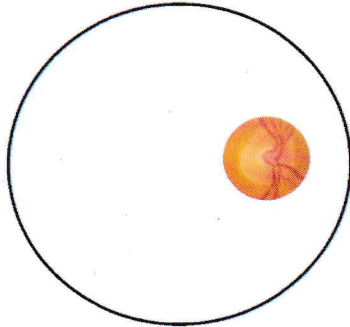


Our Office now offers Digital Retinal Imaging

without Dilation

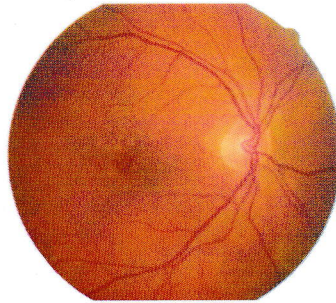
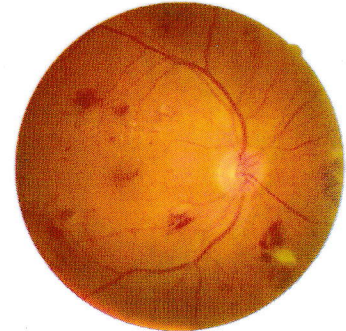


Photo of the same eye

Why is it recommended? Retinal imaging helps detect eye diseases early and helps the doctor monitor the progression of diseases. "A picture paints a thousand words." You will be able to see your photos on a monitor as the doctor reviews the results with you.

The following are some of the conditions that can be detected by retinal imaging early, often before permanent damage has occurred.

- Macular Degeneration
- Glaucoma
- Diabetic Eye Damage
- Retinal Holes and Tears
- Pre-cancerous and Cancerous Lesions
- Damage to the Arteries and Veins caused by High Blood Pressure and Cholesterol
