

The Contact Lens Examination

Important Contact Lens Consent Document

Please read and sign this document if you currently wear contact lenses and want a contact lens examination or if you are not wearing contacts and want to be evaluated for contact lens wear

Do you currently wear contacts? **Yes** **No**

Texas State Law requires that contact lens wearers have a contact lens examination every year in order to renew their prescription or buy new lenses. Contact lenses can damage the eyes and cause permanent vision loss if not fitting correctly, not properly cared for by the patient, or monitored by an eye doctor yearly. The contact lens exam **is not** part of the comprehensive eye health and refractive vision test examination.

Current contact lens wearers require additional examination time and evaluation to ensure proper lens design, fit, accuracy of prescription, and health of the eye.

In the case of a new wearer, additional time and testing is provided by the doctor to access their suitability to wear contacts.

The contact lens fee varies with complexity of the lens design, examination-fitting time and the anticipated follow up care that can be longer in some cases. Insurance or vision benefit plans may contribute allowance.

You are covered for 30-days of follow up care after the contact lens examination unless the doctor determines that more time is necessary. There will be no additional professional fees for follow up care for one month after the contact lens examination. It is your responsibility to keep all appointments within that period of time to address any issues with your contact lenses. There will be a fee for office visits and in some cases materials associated with any additional contact lens care beyond the initial usual 30- day follow up period. Due to the time restraint, it is very important that you return for all of your follow up appointments timely.

I understand that there is a separate contact lens examination fee and agree to the terms and conditions of the contact lens professional examination fee for services. I further agree on the day of my exam to pay any part of the exam fee that insurance does not contribute to. I understand the importance of returning timely for any contact lens follow up visits or material returns.

Satisfaction Guarantee

The Eye Doctor's Office has a **100% satisfaction Guarantee Program**. If **within 30 days** after the contact lens examination you are not satisfied with your contact lenses a refund for materials will be issued. In the case of soft lenses, the cost of the unopened boxes of lenses will be refunded. The lens boxes must be undamaged, with no marks or writing on them, no torn or missing labels and must be factory sealed. **Professional fees are not refundable.**
