You will notice some changes when you arrive for your next visit. We have developed policies and procedures to further ensure your safety and that of our team.

We will be following the guidelines of the American Optometric Association, Connecticut Association of Optometrists, CDC and OSHA:

- To maintain social distancing, we will limit the number of patients in the office. All patient visits will be scheduled at a specific time. This includes eye exam, office visit, special testing, contact lens check, eyewear selection, dispensing and/or glasses pick up.
