MEDICAL: An eye exam is medical when medical conditions (i.e., diabetes), eye conditions (i.e., infections, dry eyes, retinal, corneal, conjunctivitis, and cataracts) or an eye disease, such as Glaucoma is present and requires diagnosis, management, & treatment.
