Ocular Health Screening

At Premier Eyecare of Cranberry we offer state-of-the-art screening and diagnostic tools for our patients. As part of your routine eye exam, you can choose to have a digital retinal screening done in place of a dilated retinal exam. This advanced technology produces a detailed photographic image of not only the retina, but also its blood supply and the optic nerve which connects your eyes to the brain. These photos will become part of your permanent medical record and can be monitored each year for progression.

Conditions that can be detected earlier with Retinal Photography include:

- Diabetes
- Glaucoma
- Macular Degeneration
- Hypertension
- Tumors
- Cataracts
- Retinal Tears & Detachment
- Vitreous Floaters

If the digital retinal screening is refused, you also have the option of traditional dilation drops in order for your doctor to view and assess your internal eye health. Pupil dilation causes the side effects of blurred vision and light sensitivity. These side effects can impair one's ability to drive, read or carry out normal daily activities for several hours.
