The RTVue Fourier Domain OCT is the most sensitive instrument for early detection of glaucoma and retinal diseases. Using sophisticated measures, the RTVue displays cross-sectional views of your optic nerve and retina. These views will allow your doctor to gather much more detailed information during your eye exam.

An RTVue Exam provides:

1. A scan to confirm a healthy eye, or to detect the presence of disease.
2. A scan of the retina, giving your doctor a more detailed view than he can achieve by other means.
3. Comparisons to normal for both the optic nerve and retina.
4. The opportunity for you to view and discuss the RTVue images of your eye with your doctor at the time of your exam.
5. A permanent record for your medical file, enabling your doctor to make important comparisons if potential problems show themselves at a future examination.
