To provide the highest level of care, we strongly recommend that all of our patients have this procedure performed annually. It is especially important for people who have any or more of the following:

- 1. Headaches
- 2. Floaters, spots or flashes of light in vision
- 3. Family (or personal) history of hypertension or high cholesterol
- 4. Family (or personal) history of diabetes
- 5. Family (or personal) history of glaucoma
- 6. Family (or personal) history of macular degeneration or retinal disorders
- 7. Recent changes in vision
- 8. Vision not correctable to 20/20
- 9. Never had the procedure previously
- 10. Nearsightedness
- 11. Pregnant/Nursing

If pathology or unusal anatomy is documented with this testing, these image studies can be billed to your insurance as part of your treatment plan. This procedure (92250) will be billed to your "medical" insurance. Deductible, Coinsurance, and/ or copay may apply.

If the scans do not detect any unusual condition, then the photos will not be covered by insurance, and you are responsible for a fee of \$40.
