Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT) is a non-invasive imaging test. It allows the doctor to monitor diabetes, glaucoma and macular degeneration.

OCT uses light waves to take cross-section pictures of your retina. With OCT, the doctor can see each of the retina's distinctive layers. These measurements help with diagnosis of diseases, such as glaucoma, macular degeneration and diabetic eye disease.

This annual record is very valuable in assessing the current health of your eye and for safeguarding the health of specific structures of your eye, such as the retina, optic nerve, macula and blood vessels. It will also serve as an initial point of reference from which to compare as we follow your health in subsequent years.
